Buy Electric Ballasts

Want to prevent a high power bill? By using an Electric Ballast you can save up to 40% on your energy consumption compared to a Magnetic Ballast. An Electric Ballast ensures lamp efficiency and prolongs the life of the lamps; are more environmentally friendly, is up to 90% lighter, and costs far less to repair or replace.

Normal Power Points

Not all Solariums work on traditional Australian Power Points. Most Commercial Units required 3-phase power, which a normal residential property doesn't have. Be sure to purchase a solarium that doesn't require installation by an electrician, and works on a standard 240v outlet for trouble-free tanning.

Avoid Cheap Lamps

Lamps are the foundation of any good home tanning setup. Be sure to avoid cheaper lamps, as these will dramatically affect the performance of your unit. You will receive inferior results, have less efficiency, and the lamps won't last as long. Don't cheap out on lamps, or you will be disappointed by your results.
